Puppy Socialization Class

Has your cute puppy turned into a monster? Does he/she chew on the furniture, have accidents in the house, bark at or jump on people, dig holes or run away from home? Did you know that 90% of behavior problems can be prevented through puppy socialization classes and OBEDIENCE TRAINING! All dogs regardless of age can benefit from training. YES, you can “teach old dogs new tricks”.

CANNON VETERINARY SERVICES is offering puppy socialization, obedience classes and behavior counseling to teach you how to adapt the instinctive canine behavior of your dog to that of the human world. Your dog is like a mini computer! Through repetition, you program information into his/her memory. At the sound of their name and a command, they recall what their reaction should be. We teach the basic commands (heel, sit, drop, come, kennel or place, leave it or not yours). Patience, consistency, and praise are the building blocks for the obedience training. When class guidelines are followed, each dog becomes a better companion by virtue of having a self – confidence and a greater bond with their owner.

Linda Winter of CVS states; *“communication is the key ingredient in any relationship”*. The focus of this is to utilize positive reinforcement to promote a healthy relationship between you, your family, and your puppy or young dog. We teach life skills, house and social manners, as well as how to prevent behavior problems before they occur, and to solve the existing problems. Proper socialization techniques are encouraged with the other puppies and owners. The puppies are exposed to many new sights and sounds in a positive manner.

Puppy Socialization Classes run for four weeks and the cost is \$95.00. All puppies will be checked the first week of class for neck measurements, vaccination records, negative heartworm checks and an approved flea prevention program (Advantix, Frontline, or Sentinel). Attached is a registration form. Keep the top half and return the bottom portion listing the specific problems you may be experiencing along with your payment as soon as possible.
